

Made You Look!

Male birds tend to have brighter colored plumage (feathers) than their female counterparts. **Can you guess why?**

- A: Baby birds have poor vision, but they love to be entertained. The adult male birds' plumage helps them to be very visible "clowns" to babies.
- **B:** Females have duller plumage so that they can better hide themselves and their babies from predators. Also, males use their bright feathers to attract a mate!

C: The bright colors of male birds hurt the eyes of predators, so they stay away.
