“Community Canvas” is Opportunity to Make Art at the Public Market

[The Summit Federal Credit Union](#)’s popular “Community Canvas” returns to [Artist Row](#), an annual juried art show, sale and event which runs **Sunday, September 16th from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.** at the City of Rochester Public Market. Admission to the event as well as participation in the Community Canvas is **free** and open to the public.

The Summit is the primary sponsor of Artist Row, which features nearly 200 artisans as well as musical entertainment and food trucks. Additionally, WBEE’s Terry Clifford will broadcast from Artist Row between 10 a.m. and 12 p.m. on behalf of The Summit.

Kids and adults attending Artist Row may stop at The Summit’s booth and use any of a variety of supplies to create art on a square piece of paper. Everyone, regardless of art experience, is encouraged to participate. After the event, the squares are put together into a quilt-like piece, which is hung at The Summit’s Main/Winton Branch in Rochester.

“Artist Row lets us share the creativity of both the exhibiting artisans and the people who come by our booth,” said Cheryl Pohlman, Vice President of Marketing and Community Relations at The Summit.
