



The Summit Federal Credit Union's "Locally Committed" 2020 Book Scholarship Program for East High School Students

At The Summit Federal Credit Union, strengthening our community is a large and important part of what we do. By investing in the future of our youth, we help make Rochester a better place to live and work. Through The Summit's East High School "Locally Committed" Scholarship Program, we are happy to contribute to the college education of those students who share our active commitment to the community and who have distinguished themselves academically.

The Summit Federal Credit Union will award a \$500 Book Scholarship to outstanding high school seniors who attend East High School and are Summit members.

Eligibility

Each applicant must have an account at The Summit Federal Credit Union (in the applicant's name) and be a member in good standing. All applicants must be East High School seniors for the 2019/2020 school year, with plans to attend an accredited college or university for the 2020/2021 school year. The student must have an overall B average or above.

Selection Process

The winners will be selected by an independent panel of judges responsible for evaluating and ranking applications received based on three separate criteria – community involvement (includes sports, volunteer work and activities outside of the standard school curriculum), essay response and academic performance. Applicants should have documented contributions within their community – an important characteristic that defines all credit unions, our cooperative structure and our roots as volunteer-driven organizations.

Application Process

Please complete the scholarship application in full. Include a copy of your activities/extracurricular/community service resume and one additional sheet for your essay response.

Please note: You do **not** have to submit an official copy of your SAT, ACT scores or high school transcript. Confirmation of grades will be handled by The Summit's selection committee and East High School's guidance office.
