A penny is worth one cent (1¢).

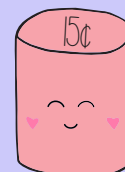
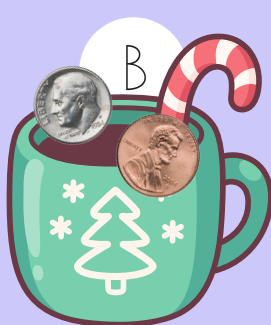


A nickel is worth five cents (5¢), like five pennies.
