Families! What are needs and wants?

Teaching your child about “needs” and “wants” early on can be easy! If your child regularly goes to the store with you, here’s a convenient exercise. If they can read, let them hold the grocery list and identify those items to them as “needs.” If it’s on the list, it’s a “need,” if not, it’s a “want.” As you walk through the aisles picking up items, ask your child if it’s a “need” or a “want.” For example, dish soap is on the list, so it’s a need. Ice cream isn’t on the list, so that’s a “want.”
