

The Summit Federal Credit Union's 2026 Skilled Trade Scholarship Program

At The Summit Federal Credit Union, strengthening our community is a large and important part of what we do. By investing in the future of our youth, we help make our communities better places to live and work. Through The Summit's Scholarship Program, we are happy to contribute to the tuition and job-related expenses of those students pursuing an Associate's Degree, Certificate or Diploma at a trade school, technical institute, technical certification program or apprentice program.

The Summit Federal Credit Union will award scholarships to outstanding high school seniors who are Summit members.

Eligibility

Each applicant must have an account at The Summit Federal Credit Union (in the applicant's name) and be a member in good standing. All applicants must be a high school senior for the 2025/2026 school year, with plans to get an Associate's Degree, Certificate or Diploma at a trade school, technical institute, technical certification program or apprentice program for the 2026/2027 school year. Students must have an overall C average or above.

Selection Process

The winners will be selected by a panel of judges responsible for evaluating and ranking applications received based on three separate criteria – community involvement (includes sports, volunteer work and activities outside of the standard school curriculum), and responses to the questions posed in this application. Applicants should have documented contributions within their community – an important characteristic that defines all credit unions, our cooperative structure and our roots as volunteer-driven organizations.

Application Process

Please complete the scholarship application in full. Include a copy of your Activities/Extracurricular/Community Service Resume, preferably in a PDF or Word document.

Please note: Submission of an official copy of your high school transcript is required. Transcripts must be mailed or emailed directly from the school. It is the student's responsibility to ensure their high school transcripts have been submitted.
